

Sponsor a Flagstone at St Mary's Church, Bedfont

St Mary's Church has been in Bedfont for over a thousand years. This much loved church now needs your help. You can sponsor a flagstone to help us raise £250,000 to replace the floor and the under-floor heating and thus protect the fabric of the church for future generations.

Sponsoring a flagstone is easy - at £60 each for a full flagstone or £30 for a half. Perhaps you would like to sponsor one to mark a special event in your family life, or in memory of someone you love. Or maybe you and a friend would like to sponsor one flagstone between you.

Anyone who joins in with this scheme before the 20th January 2018 will have their names inserted into a time capsule to be buried into the floor as the work is completed. A book recording all sponsorships will be created and will eventually be placed on view within the Church.
